## E-Services Phone Forum Series Offered in Spring-Summer 2006

Did you know since January, 2006 that nearly **54 thousand** individuals have registered for IRS e-Services? Check out how many "online" requests for information the IRS has received since then:

- ✓ Over **24 thousand** requests for client online POA,
- ✓ Over **5 thousand** electronic account resolution inquiries, and
- ✓ Over **3.5 million** requests for electronic transcript information

And the number of those making these requests has increased by over 300% from 2005!

**Who are they?** They are *e-Filing* practitioners and other eligible entities that have registered for and are using the IRS' online e-Services!

As a result of feedback received directly from practitioners like you, the IRS will offer a series of educational phone forums (seminars conducted by conference call) on registration for and use of incentive e-Services, that is, Disclosure Authorization (DA), Transcript Delivery System (TDS), and Electronic Account Resolution (EAR), as well as an opportunity to **earn Continuing Education credits**.

These free, unique and timely events will occur this May, July and August. Here's the schedule.

After the forum and if you stayed on the call for the entire seminar, you will be e-mailed a letter of completion that will qualify for Enrolled Agent and CTEC continuing education credit. Credit may be available to CPAs – check with your state's board of accountancy.

We try to standardize our boxes as much as possible by using the case boxes of paper.

### From NAEA, New SEE , June 7, 2006:

Dear NAEA Member,

IRS just released a [press release](#) providing more information about the **new Special Enrollment Examination** and the government relations department wanted to inform the membership immediately. The release focuses on two items of note:

1. The new examination will be in three parts
  - a. individuals
  - b. corporations
  - c. representation, practice and procedures
2. The IRS will allow previous SEE testers to carry over scores from past exams, subject to certain conditions

NAEA has been involved closely with Thomson Prometric in the design of this exam and has exclusively provided not only subject matter experts but also participants at a one-day test specification meeting. In both cases, our members helped determine what knowledge areas were covered in the test and the relative importance of those items. Further, we provided more than a dozen members for a four-day long item writing workshop, at which the questions for the upcoming examination were written. Clearly, more clarification is necessary (e.g., on what interval will the examination be offered, how much will it cost, when will prospective EAs be able to register) and NAEA will share this information as soon as we receive credible information.

**CSEA Board of Directors Meeting  
And Annual Meeting, Reno, NV, May 29, 30, & 31 2006**

May's meeting in Reno was in conjunction with the Annual Meeting and Super Seminar. Committee meetings on Sunday May 28<sup>th</sup>, General Board and Committee Meetings on the 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup>, Annual Meeting on the 31<sup>st</sup> with the Grand Banquet in the evening of the 31<sup>st</sup>. CSEA Awards were voted upon at the Board Meeting and announced at the Grand Banquet the evening of the Annual Meeting. Many committee motions were brought to the board and passed by the Directors. There are changes to the Chapter Affiliation Agreement. The minimum number of members to sustain chapter status was increased from 15 to 35 members. The other significant change was that the term of agreement shall continue until amended. It is no longer necessary to do an annual review. The Legislative Action Fund (LAF) request and received additional funds to pay remaining expenses for 2005-2006 and a subsidy to cover anticipated expenses for fiscal year 2006-2007. The amounts were \$7000 and \$40000 respectively.

Scholarship Fund received 29 applications and upon scoring them, requested the Board to approve all scholarship applications and award each a scholarship. The Board approved the amount of \$14,065.06 to be distributed among each of the applicants. We need to get the word out to the tax preparer and academic community of the existence of these scholarships. What a great source of future EA's.

The PIA (Public Information Awareness) Committee received board approval to change the We SpEAK Tax service mark from The Taxpayer's Tax Experts to The Tax Professionals. To protect our right to continue to use our We SpEAK Tax service marks, the board approved a \$2000 expenditure to register the three phrases, We SpEAK Tax, the Taxpayer's Tax Experts and the Tax Professionals.

May 2007 marks the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of CSEA. To commemorate this occasion, Membership Committee received board approval to produce 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary pins. These will be distributed to all EA Members at no cost to the member. Extra pins will be sold and can be distributed to those who support CSEA and wish to display their support of 30 years of service to the Enrolled Agents by the California Society of Enrolled Agents.

**BREAKING NEWS FROM CSEA, Wednesday, 6/7/2006**  
**WRONGLY DENIED FORMS 4868 UPDATE**

The following information is being provided by the IRS Fresno Campus Submission Processing Unit regarding the denied Forms 4868 that were timely filed:

The Service recently became aware that some taxpayers may have been erroneously denied an extension of time to file their tax return. A human error occurred in affixing the proper date stamp to certain Form 4868 extension requests at the IRS Fresno Campus. Most of the impacted forms were transmitted in bulk from paid preparers. The IRS estimates that 45,000 - 50,000 taxpayers may be affected.

The IRS is now reviewing all of the denied extensions to determine which ones were accurately denied. In cases where the IRS can identify the paid preparer who bulk-mailed the extensions which were incorrectly denied, the IRS will notify the practitioner. **If IRS cannot identify a paid preparer then the taxpayer will receive a letter advising them that their extension is approved and that they may ignore the previous, incorrect correspondence.** The IRS estimates its review of the denied extensions and subsequent mailings to taxpayers and practitioners will be completed before the end of June.

Taxpayers who believe their extension was improperly denied by the IRS Fresno Campus need take no action at this time. If the taxpayer received a denial letter and does not receive further correspondence by the end of June, the taxpayer may request a reconsideration of their case by following the instructions in the denial letter. Since the IRS is already reviewing their case, the Service asks all taxpayers who mailed an extension request to Fresno to wait until the end of June before taking any action.
